### **INTRODUCTION**



- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend the terms of the Funding Agreement and wish to record their agreement as to such variations/amendments to the Funding Agreement by this Deed.

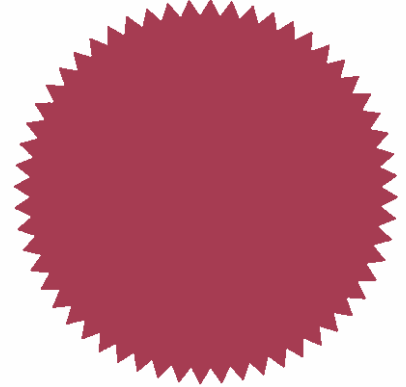
### **LEGAL AGREEMENT**

- 3. As varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.





## **Schedule 1**

### **Amendments to the Funding Agreement**

1. Clause 17 of the Funding Agreement shall be replaced with:

The planned capacity of the Academy is 1,300 in the age range 11-19, including a sixth form of 250 places. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive school whose requirements for:

- a) the admission of pupils to the Academy are set out in Annex B to the Funding Agreement
- b) the admission to the Academy of and support for pupils with SEN and with disabilities (for pupils who have and who do not have statements of SEN) are set out in Annex C to the Funding Agreement
- c) pupil exclusions are set out in Annex D to the Funding Agreement
