



MODIFICATION OF Charity Commission Scheme dated 1 September 1956

The Secretary of State for Education, in exercise of the power in section 82 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998, makes the following Order to modify the Charity Commission Scheme of the Blue Coat and National Schools dated 19 September 1956.

Before making this Order the Secretary of State has consulted, in accordance with section 82(2) of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998, the following persons - the Governing Body and Trustees of the Blue Coat CE Comprehensive School, Walsall, and the Lichfield Diocesan Authority.

From 1 September 2012 the Charity Commission Scheme is modified as follows:

1. Definitions

In this Order:-

“Charity” means the charitable trust identified at the beginning of this Order;

“Governing Document” means the Charity Commission Scheme dated 19 September 1956;

“Trustees” means the trustees of the Charity acting under the existing trusts;

2. Administration

The Charity shall be administered in accordance with the existing Governing Document as altered or affected by this Order.

3. Alteration of the existing trusts

(1) Clause 11 shall be amended to include the following new definition:-

“Education Acts” means the Education Acts as defined in section 578 of the Education Act 1996 and includes any regulations made under the Education Acts;

(2) Clause 11 shall be amended by the deletion in line 2 of the word “voluntary” so that the clause shall be read and construed as follows:-

11. The Schools of the Foundation, namely the Walsall Blue Coat Church of England Secondary School and the Walsall Blue Coat Church of England Primary School, shall be conducted as schools in which religious instruction in accordance with the doctrines of the Church of England shall be given.
