## **DEED OF VARIATION**

The parties to this Deed are:

(1) The Secretary of State for Education ("the Secretary of State"),

(2) The Aspirations Academies Trust, a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 7867577 ("the Academy").

### **INTRODUCTION**

- A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated 31/1/2013 ("the Funding Agreement") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an independent school known as Harriers Banbury Academy.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend the terms of the Funding Agreement and wish to record their agreement as to such variations/amendments to the Funding Agreement by this Deed.

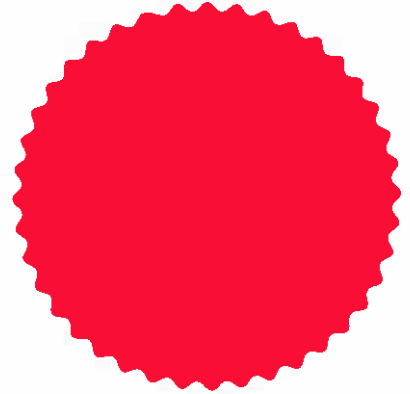
### **LEGAL AGREEMENT**

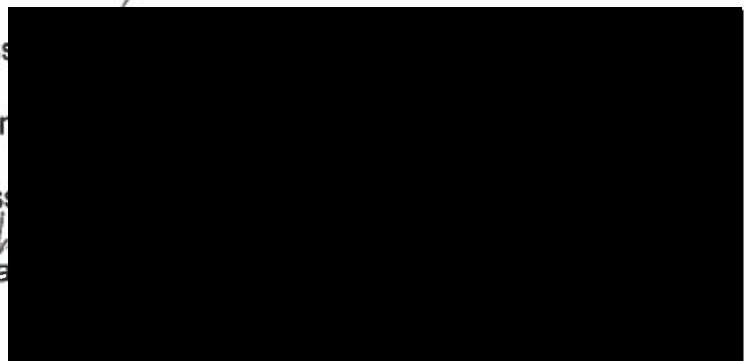
