## DEED OF VARIATION TO THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

THIS DEED is made the 30 day of June 2017

### BETWEEN

- 1) The Secretary of State for Education (the "**Secretary of State**"); and
- 2) The Shropshire Gateway Educational Trust (the "**Company**") a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 9115941 together, the "**Parties**".

### INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a supplemental funding agreement dated on or about 25<sup>th</sup> August 2015 (the "**Funding Agreement**") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an Academy known as Stottesdon CofE Primary School, in accordance with the Funding Agreement.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend certain terms and conditions of the Funding Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Deed.
- C. This Deed is supplemental to the Funding Agreement.

### 1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Funding Agreement.

### 2. VARIATION OF THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

- 2.1 The Parties agree that with effect from the date of this Deed, the Supplemental Funding Agreement shall be amended as follows:

#### 2.1.1 SUMMARY SHEET

- 2.1.2 Clause 1.C of the Supplemental Funding Agreement shall include the following definition:

"**Early Years Provision**" has the same meaning as that given by s.20 Childcare Act 2006

- 2.1.3 Clause 2.B of the Supplemental Funding Agreement shall be replaced with:

The planned capacity of the Academy is 110, which includes a nursery provision of 20 places, in the the age range 2 – 11. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive school.

2.1.4 The following clause shall be inserted after Clause 3.K of the Supplemental Funding Agreement:

3.L Grants paid by the Secretary of State (be they GAG, EAG or Capital Grant) shall not be used by the Academy Trust for Early Years Provision.

2.2 Except as varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

**3. Governing law and jurisdiction**

3.1 This Deed, and any disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.

3.2 The parties irrevocably agree that the English courts have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Deed or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

**4. Counterparts**

4.1 This Deed may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties to it on separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, but all the counterparts shall together constitute one and the same instrument.
